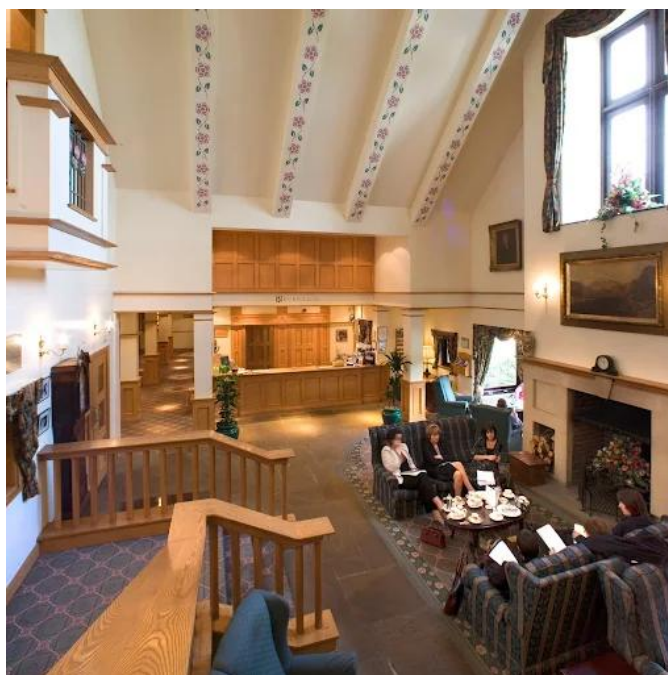

Lecture & Dinner Venue:

The Saturday & Sunday mornings lecture programme along with the Conference Dinner on the Saturday evening will be held at the Lancaster Hotel. Saturday Afternoon Excursion to Lancaster Castle:

Travel Arrangements:

The Hotel is within a couple of miles of Lancaster Centre and easily reached from Junction 33 of the M6 Motor Way.

There is a direct trainline from London Euston to Lancaster and takes about 2 ½ hrs. Taxis are available at that station.

The nearest major airport is Manchester. Though flying into London and taking the train to Lancaster would be another option.

Conference Papers:

The Conference Registration Desk will open in the Hotel Foyer on Friday afternoon (2nd) between 16.00 – 17.30 for collection of conference papers and name badges.
